

Protocol on cooperation between the State Intellectual Property Office and the Agency for Medicinal Products and Medical Devices

On 15 February 2007 the Protocol on cooperation between the State Intellectual Property Office and the Agency for Medicinal Products and Medical Devices was signed, aiming to develop close long-term cooperation on related issues in the field of intellectual property on one hand, and of putting drugs and medical products into circulation on the other hand.

Based on this Protocol and within their legal authorities the institutions will cooperate on further promoting and developing an efficient national system of patent protection of pharmaceutical and medical products and putting these products into circulation on the market in the Republic of Croatia.

Under this Protocol the institutions shall regularly exchange relevant information on new initiatives of legislative and practical nature in the field of patent protection and in the field of drugs and medical products, both at national and international level.

Apart from exchange of information and official publications, the experts of both Parties shall exchange their practical experiences through regular mutual contacts, mutually inform about issues of common interest and identify problems in proceedings conducted before both Parties.
