1. INTRODUCTION

In compliance with the obligations of the Republic of Croatia to continually monitor statistical data relating to the enforcement of intellectual property rights, the methodology of data collection and preparation of statistical reports was adopted in 2008.

With the purpose of further developing and enhancing this methodology, an expert working group for statistics about implementing intellectual property rights was established in 2010. The working group has been active within the system of the Coordinating body for implementing intellectual property rights, established at the level of the Republic of Croatia in 2010, and organised by the Coordinating committee for the implementation of intellectual property rights.

The State intellectual property office pursues the coordination of statistical data collection, compilation and publication of statistical reports; data on the infringements of intellectual property rights are communicated to the State Attorney Office of the Republic of Croatia, Ministry of the Interior of the Republic of Croatia, Ministry of Finance-Customs Administration of the Republic of Croatia, Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Croatia and State Inspectorate of the Republic of Croatia.

The reports are showing data relating to the criminal, misdemeanour and civil procedures conducted before the competent bodies in the Republic of Croatia concerning the infringements of intellectual property rights, and the customs proceedings conducted against goods raising reasonable doubt of infringing intellectual property rights.

Such reports are prepared and published every three months (quarterly), and integral annual statistical reports are also published, containing collected data analyses in minute detail, as well.
